



**“Attempted traffic stop and collision result in arrests of adult and juvenile in Westminster”**

**Westminster, Carroll County, Maryland; July 29, 2025** ---- On Tuesday, July 29, 2025 at approximately 12:02 AM, deputies observed a gray Nissan sedan traveling at a high rate of speed on Route 27 and Route 482. Deputies attempted to make a traffic stop as the vehicle traveled out of view from officers.

The vehicle was later located by Westminster City Police on Gentry Court. Upon law enforcement officers entering the cul-de-sac, the driver of the Nissan utilized his vehicle to ram two Westminster City Police vehicles and one Sheriff's Office vehicle. The suspect vehicle became disabled as a result. The adult male driver and three passengers, one of which was a juvenile, exited the vehicle and fled on foot. One adult male was taken into custody on scene, and two others were apprehended following a thorough search of the area. The driver was identified as 19 year old Braylon Roberts of Pennsylvania. Roberts was transported to Carroll Hospital for evaluation prior to intake at Carroll County Central Booking for the following charges: Assault - First Degree, Assault - Second Degree (3 counts), Reckless Endangerment (2 counts), Assault Second Degree - LE/P&P/Fire/EM, and numerous traffic violations.

The juvenile was also taken into custody, transported to the Carroll County Sheriff's Office, and released after consultation with the Department of Juvenile Services.

Two Westminster City Police officers were taken to Carroll Hospital Center for non-life-threatening injuries sustained in the vehicle collisions. The case remains under investigation by the Carroll County Sheriff's Office.

All suspects are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
