



“Sheriff’s Office traffic stop leads to arrests for CDS Possession with Intent to Distribute”

Westminster, Carroll County, Maryland; January 15, 2026 ---- On Wednesday, January 14th, 2026, at approximately 12:46PM, members of the Pro-Active Community Enforcement (PACE) Team were conducting traffic enforcement on Baltimore Boulevard when they observed a Kia Sedona with a Virginia temporary tag travelling westbound from Baltimore County into Carroll County. A traffic stop was initiated for a tint violation as well as for failure to obey a traffic control device.

The vehicle stopped in the 1400 Block of Baltimore Boulevard in Westminster. The driver was identified as Tremaine Gordon Eugene Bishop, a 28-year-old male, and the passenger as Robert Lee Johnson 3rd, a 24-year-old male, both of Baltimore County.

Based on observations, a K9 scan for Controlled Dangerous Substances was requested, and resulted in a positive alert for the odor of CDS.

During the subsequent search of the vehicle and occupants, 31.2 grams of suspected cocaine, 13.2 grams of suspected fentanyl, six cell phones, a digital scale, CDS packaging materials, and \$931.00 in U.S. Currency was found and secured as evidence.

Bishop and Johnson 3rd were both arrested and transported to Carroll County Central Booking.

Bishop and Johnson 3rd were each charged with 7 offenses related to the possession and distribution of CDS.

Both subjects were held without bail and currently remain at the Carroll County Detention Center.

(All individuals are presumed innocent of the pending charges until proven guilty in a court of law)
