



“Suspects fail to comply with court ordered eviction”

Westminster, Carroll County, Maryland; February 26, 2026 ---- On Wednesday, February 25, 2026, at approximately 8:40 am, Carroll County Sheriff's Office Deputies responded to the 3400 block of Littlestown Pike for a court ordered eviction. The occupants refused to exit the house.

Out of an abundance of caution, the Carroll County Crisis Response Team and Crisis Negotiation Team were called to the scene in an attempt to resolve the incident. Due to their refusal to comply, warrants were obtained for the occupants of the residence, identified as Edwin Eugene Bell, a 68 year-old male, and Miranda Cisneros Bell, a 55 year-old female.

Both subjects were taken into custody just after 3 pm. They were transported to Carroll County Central Booking and served with the warrants, charging them with burglary, trespass, false statement to an officer, and fail to obey lawful order.

(All individuals are presumed innocent of the pending charges until proven guilty in a court of law)

Both subjects posted bail and were released.
