



“Joint Investigation Leads to Two Subjects Facing Charges Related to Theft and Police Chase on Route 140”

Westminster, Carroll County, Maryland; June 26, 2026 ---- On Tuesday, June 23rd, 2026, at approximately 3:39 PM, a theft in progress was reported to the Westminster Police Department at the Lowes store located at 777 Market Street, Westminster, MD 21157. Lowes provided suspect and vehicle descriptions and advised responding officers that the suspects fled in a vehicle that left in the direction of Route 140. A member of the Carroll County Sheriff's Office Pro-Active Community Enforcement (PACE) Team located the suspect vehicle, a 2015 black in color Nissan Altima traveling east on Route 140 and attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The suspect(s) fled in the vehicle east on 140 and into Baltimore County where the pursuit was eventually terminated.

Through further investigation by the Carroll County Sheriff's Office & Westminster Police Department, with the assistance of the Howard County Police Department, and the Harford County Sheriff's Office, the driver was identified as Kevin Vern Green, a 50-year-old male with a listed Baltimore address. The passenger was identified as David William Hayes, a 42-year-old male with a Bel Air address, who was currently a fugitive, wanted by the Harford County Sheriff's Office. Both subjects are believed to be involved in several other similar thefts across the Baltimore region.

On June 24, 2026, David Hayes was located and arrested by the Howard County Police Department and is currently being held at the Harford County Detention Center for charges in their jurisdiction. Hayes is facing charges in Carroll County for Theft \$1,500-\$25,000, Theft \$100-\$1,500, and Theft Scheme.

On June 25, 2026, Kevin Green was arrested by the Carroll County Sheriff's Office PACE Team and Warrant unit with the assistance of the Howard County Police Department at a motel in Elkridge, MD. Green was transported to the Carroll County Detention Center and has been charged with Fleeing & Eluding Uniformed Police in Vehicle, Reckless Driving, Possession of CDS not Marijuana, and CDS Possession in Place of Confinement.

Green is currently being held without bail at the Carroll County Detention Center. At this time, Hayes remains in custody at the Harford County Detention Center. (All individuals are presumed innocent of the pending charges until proven guilty in a court of law)
